EVENT PLANNING SERIES

A tournament or competitive fishing event involves release of the tournament fish once they have been weighed and the weight recorded. It can take place in a single day, or over a two to four day period. The angler, or team, with the largest total weight is declared the winner.

In order to ensure the sustainability of the fishery, seriously consider targeting less popular species of fish. Contact your district fisheries office and get copies of fishing regulations and other fishing-related materials.

Number of participants:

The nature and location of your event will be the primary deciding factor in the number of anglers to host. A safe and enjoyable event should be your primary goal.

Timing:

Events can be held any time of year where water or ice conditions are safe. Whether you choose summer or winter, particular attention must be paid to ice and fast water conditions.
