Equipment could include everything from public address systems, fishing equipment (rods, reels, line, bobbers, snap swivels, split shot sinkers), life jackets to picnic tables, toilet facilities and garbage cans.

Downplay the importance of prizes. If you want to offer prizes keep their value to a minimum or provide a goody bag for each participant. Put emphasis on participation, learning and fun.

Food is not necessary at every event, but if yours is going to last several hours, some sort of refreshment should be provided, especially when children are involved. Identify potential food sources and coordinate event delivery and participation, or contract a local community or charitable organization to sell refreshments at your event.
